- **Goal Development** - Based on the ORIS results and the data review, the team decided upon two umbrella School Improvement Goals; Attendance and Equity/Inclusion.

Some of the strategies discussed for the attendance goal were to focus on more Tier 1 school wide strategies, such as attendance challenges, or to create a strategies to reduce barrier for families, such as partnering with Safe Routes to School for carpools and walking groups. For the equity/inclusion goal, the team discussed ideas such as starting affinity groups, reinvigorating parent involvement after two years of mostly virtual parent involvement, and also taking a particularly close look at supporting ELD students, who stood out when we looked at attendance, discipline, and academic data.
